

Veterinary Technician Position

The University of Texas at San Antonio is a rapidly growing research community, which is moving toward AAALAC accreditation and tier one status. The institution is therefore looking for a highly motivated person to fill the position of Veterinary Technician within the Laboratory Animal Resources Center (LARC).

Minimum Requirements

- Experience using a personal computer and standard office equipment.
- Associates degree, preferably in Science from an accredited institution plus one of the following:
 - 1) Licensure as a Registered Veterinary Technician (RVT) or
 - 2) AALAS certification at the ALAT level and the ability to obtain certification at the LAT level within 18 months of hire date.
- Two years of experience as a Veterinary Technician, preferably in the lab animal field.

Summary of Duties

- Performs medical surveillance, diagnostic support and treatment of clinical cases, which include identification of sick animals, contacting investigators, following veterinary orders, documentation of cases, etc.
- Administers sentinel testing program and performs animal health monitoring.
- Assists the Quality Assurance (QA)/Training Coordinator with various aspects of the training program, including conducting classes and setting up for various hands on workshops.
- Assists QA/Training Coordinator with environmental monitoring.
- Coordinates and performs anesthesia equipment training, scheduling, maintenance and set up for researchers use.
- Monitors surgeries in researcher's labs.
- Responsible for maintenance and restock of LARC diagnostic/veterinary supplies, equipment and procedural rooms.
- Performs routine veterinary technical skills including:
 - administration of various therapeutic measures by IV, IM, SQ, topical oral routes, etc.
 - proficient animal restraint techniques
 - tissue sampling
 - other routine animal manipulations.
- Assists QA/Training Coordinator with implementation of Occupational Health & Safety Program.
- Assists in providing leadership, animal health training and guidance to other laboratory personnel.
- Demonstrates excellent organizational, time management and recordkeeping skills.
- Perform all other related duties as assigned.
